

1957 AMENDMENTS—STATES HAVE CHOICE OF 1 OF 2 METHODS FOR COMPUTING FEDERAL SHARE

METHOD 1. ASSISTANCE SUBJECT TO FEDERAL PARTICIPATION DEFINED TO INCLUDE MONEY PAYMENTS TO RECIPIENTS AND PAYMENTS TO VENDORS FOR MEDICAL AND REMEDIAL CARE

Effective, July 1, 1957–Sept. 30, 1958.....	\$60	\$32 plus \$32 for 1 needy relative with whom child lives.	\$23	$\frac{4}{5}$ of 1st \$30 (average) plus $\frac{1}{2}$ bal- ance.	$\frac{14}{17}$ of 1st \$17 (average per person) plus $\frac{1}{2}$ balance.
