signals, or of any neglect to keep a proper lookout, or of the neglect of any precaution which may be required by the ordinary practice of the air, or by the special circumstances of the case.

133. Special orders relative to navigation of aircraft in the immediate vicinity of an aerodrome.—Nothing in this Part shall interfere with the operation of any special rule or rules approved by the Central Government and published relative to navigation of aircraft in the immediate vicinity of any aerodrome or other place, and it shall be obligatory on all owners, pilots, or crews of aircraft to obey such rules.
