

contract, the salary allowable as costs shall be that salary normally paid by the Contractor for the performance of such duties. In the event any individual employed under this contract is discharged because of inability to secure a security clearance from the United States Government, the salary and transportation of such individual during the time he was in the employ of the Contractor shall be an allowable cost hereunder.

(3) The cost which the Government has agreed to assume under the clauses hereof entitled "Government Property" and "Insurance-Liability to Third Persons", including the cost of such extra-hazardous insurance as may be approved by the Contracting Officer under the provisions of subparagraph (9) of this section.

(4) Transportation and reasonable subsistence of personnel employed in the performance of this contract while in travel status. Transportation and subsistence costs of Corporate Officers of the Contractor while in travel status in connection with this contract.

(5) Charges for the use of equipment, other than Government-furnished equipment, utilized in the performance of the contract, provided, however that such charges shall not exceed the cost of the services accomplished by the use of such equipment if such services were procured commercially.

(6) The cost of maintaining offices in Oakland, California and any other place or places as may be directed by the Contract Administrator, in connection with the performance of this contract.
