nessmen or business concerns in other countries and be exempt from the antitrust laws so long as they operate under those arrangements; or (b) amend the antitrust laws to grant the necessary authority for

such purposes.

7. State the sense of the Congress that the President should, as soon as practicable, undertake negotiations within the most appropriate organization to work out a common approach and appropriate institutional framework for the conduct of trade between market-type economies and the Communist-dominated countries. I suggest for this purpose the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).

8. State the sense of the Congress that the delegation of the President's authority under the Export Control Act of 1949 to the Commerce Department should be accompanied by an instruction to carry out its responsibilities in a manner calculated to heighten the enective ness of our export controls by coordinating our policies and practices

with those of the other advanced industrial nations.
