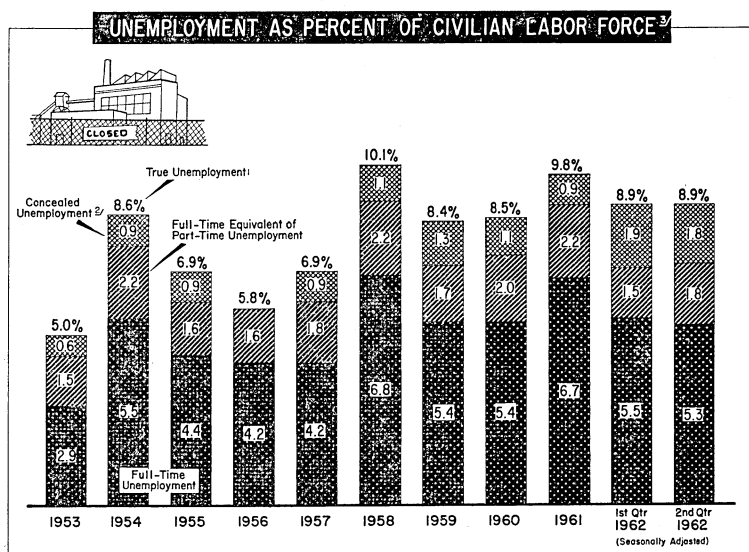
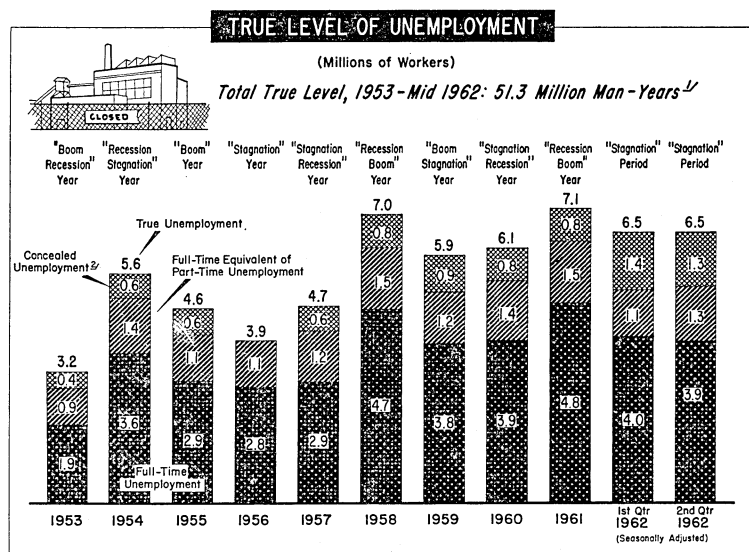


CHRONIC RISE OF UNEMPLOYMENT, 1953-1962
