PREFACE

This document includes information on the utilization of all automatic data processing (ADP) equipment in the executive branch of the Federal Government, except for equipment which is used in military operational and certain classified activities within the Department of Defense.

The information is based on reports prepared by the Federal agencies in accordance with Bureau of the Budget Circular A-55, dated March 14, 1962, subject: Annual reports on the utilization of automatic data processing equipment in the executive branch.

Tables I through IV contain tabulations of the data reported by the agencies. Table I contains a summary tabulation by agency. Tables II, III, and IV contain listings of computer installations; each of these tables contains the same information, but is arranged in a different form; i.e., Table II lists the installations by agency, Table III lists them by geographic location, and Table IV lists them by make and model.

Highlights of the information contained in these tables are presented in graphic form in Charts 1 through 9 which precede the tables. Each chart is accompanied by an explanatory text. Historical data obtained from previous years' reports are included in some charts to portray trends.

Data for fiscal year 1961 and prior years are on an actual basis; data for fiscal years 1962 and 1963 are estimates.

Explanations of certain terms used throughout the document, and listings of codes by which the Federal departments and the computer makes and models may be fully identified are found in Appendixes A, B, and C, respectively.
