COMPUTER UTILIZATION - HOURS PER MONTH

1. Seven hundred fifty-one (75 percent) of the 1006 computers installed at the end of FY 1962 were reported operating at least 176 hours per month--which is the equivalent of a normal 40-hour work week and is the number of hours for which a basic minimum monthly rental charge is made. Two hundred fifty-five (25 percent) were reported operating less than 176 hours per month.

2. Two hundred forty-four (24 percent) were reported operating at least 352 hours per month (the equivalent of a 2-shift day); 59 (6 percent) were reported operating at least 528 hours per month (3-shift day).

3. The average utilization for all computers reported was 267 hours per month.
