§ 22-2401 through 22-2404 1st Degree: Pre-meditated malice or the killing while perpetrating certain crimes. Penalty: Shall be death unless the jury by a unanimous vote recommends life imprisonment: if the jury is unable to agree the court impose a sentence of death or life imprisonment. 2nd Degree: Act with malice aforethought except those defined as 1st degree. Penalty: Shall be imprisoned for life or not less than 20 years.	§ 22-2405 Without malice aforethought, sudden heat of passion. (63 F. Supl. 968). Penalty: Shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or by imprisonment by imprisonment 15 years or both.	§ 22-2901 By force or violence, whether against resistance or by sudden or stealthy seizure or snatching or by putting in fear shall take from the person or immediate actual possession of another, anything of value. Penalty: Shall suffer imprisonment for not less than 6 months nor more than 15 years.	§ 22-501 Assault with the intent to kill, rob, rape, or poison. Penalty: Shall be imprisoned for not more than 15 years. § 22-502. Assault with intent to commit mayhem or with a dangerous weapon. Penalty: Shall be imprisoned for not more than 10 years.	§ 22-1401 Maliciously burning or attempting to burn any dwelling, etc. Penalty: Shall be imprisoned for not less than 1 year nor more than 10 years. No general provision.

§ 22-1801 Offense is termed "house-breaking". The entering of any dwelling, etc. with the intent to break and carry away anything connected therewith, or to commit any criminal act. Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not more than 15 years.	§ 22-2201 The feloniously taking and carrying away of anything of value in the amount of value of \$100 and upwards. Penalty: shall suffer imprisonment for not less than one nor more than ten years.	§ 22-1202 Wrongful converting of property to own use which has come into contact or possession by virtue of employment. Penalty: shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than ten years or both.	§ 22-2801 The carnal knowledge of a female forcibly and against her will, or carnal knowledge and abuse of a female child under 16 years. Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not more than 30 years. Death, if jury, in their verdict, adds the words "with the death penalty."	§ 22-3204 Carrying either openly or concealed, a pistol unless licensed, or any deadly or dangerous weapon, capable of being concealed. Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not more than ten years.
