§ 41-2227 1st Degree: Shall suffer death or life imprisonment at hard labor. § 43-2153 allows life imprisonment at jury's discretion. 2nd Degree: Shall be sentenced to imprisonment not less than 5 nor more than 21 years (Jury to find degree).	§ 41-2229 Whoever convicted shall undergo imprisonment in "said jail and penitentiary house" for not less than 2 nor more than 7 years.	§ 41-3602 Punishment shall be imprisonment for not less than 3 nor more than 21 years.	§ 41-603 Punishment shall be fine not less than \$100 nor exceeding \$1000 and imprisonment not exceeding 1 year.	§ 41-501 Penalty shall be imprisonment for not less than 1 nor more than 10 years. (Jury's discretion.)	§§ 41-4501, 41-4503 Shall be punishment by fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 or by imprisonment in county jail for not less than 30 days nor more than 3 months, or both.
