§§ 190 & 190.1 1st Degree: Penalty shall be death or imprisonment for life at jury's or court's discretion. (Penalty verdict if by jury must be unanimous). No death penalty for one under 18 at time of crime. 2nd Degree: Is punishable by imprisonment from 5 years to life.	§ 193 Penalty is imprisonment for not exceeding 10 years.	§ 213 1st Degree: Penalty is imprisonment for not less than 5 years. 2nd Degree: Penalty is imprisonment for not less than 1 year.	§ 220 Assault with intent to commit mayhem is punishable by imprisonment not less than 1 nor more than 20 years. § 245 Assault with deadly weapon is punishable by imprisonment not exceeding 10 years or in county jail not exceeding 1 year or by fine not exceeding \$5000 or by both fine and imprisonment.	§ 447a Penalty shall be imprisonment for not less than 2 nor more than 20 years.	§ 644 Habitual criminals. After two previous felony convictions life imprisonment.

§ 461 1st Degree: Penalty is imprisonment for not less than 5 years. 2nd Degree: Penalty is imprisonment for not less than 1 year nor more than 15 years or imprisonment in county jail not exceeding 1 year.	§ 489 Penalty is imprisonment for not more than 10 years or imprisonment in county jail for not more than one year.	§ 514 Penalty is imprisonment for not more than 10 years or imprisonment in county jail for not more than 1 year. (Reference back to § 489.)	§ 264 Penalty is imprisonment for not less than three years (special exceptions where girl is under 18).	§ 12020 Penalty: Punishment shall be imprisonment in county jail not exceeding 1 year or in state prison for not less than 1 nor more than 5 years.
