§ 40-2-3 1st Degree: Penalty shall be death or imprisonment for life at hard labor. (Jury's discretion). 2nd Degree: Penalty shall be imprisonment for a term not less than 10 years and which may extend to life.	§ 40-2-8 Penalty shall be imprisonment for not less than 1 year which may extend to 8 years.	§ 40-5-1 Penalty shall be imprisonment for not less than 1 nor more than 14 years unless he or confederate armed with dangerous weapon in which case penalty shall be 2 years or life. § 40-3-6 Penalty: Punishment shall be imprisonment for not less than 1 nor more than 10 years.	§ 40-5-2 Penalty: shall be imprisonment not less than 1 nor more than 10 years.	§ 40-5-16 Penalty: shall be imprisonment not less than 1 nor more than 10 years by punishing as for larceny. (§ 40-5-2)	§ 40-2-28 Penalty: is at the discretion of the court - imprisonment for life or for not less than 3 years.	§ 40-11-1 Penalty: shall be imprisonment in jail for not more than 1 year or by fine not more than \$500 or by both.
