\$ 10-3401 1st Degree: Shall be death or life imprisonment. 2nd Degree: Shall be imprisonment during life.	\$ 10-3405 Penalty shall be imprisonment not less than 2 nor more than 21 yrs.	\$ 10-4101 Penalty shall be imprisonment for not less than 10 nor more than 25 years and disfranchisement for period. For physical injury inflicted during robbery penalty shall be life imprisonment.	\$ 10-410 Aggravated assault and battery offender shall be imprisoned for not less than 1 year nor more than 5 years and may be fined not to exceed \$1,000.	\$ 10-301 1st Degree: (dwelling) Shall be imprisonment not less than 2 nor more than 14 years. 2nd Degree (not dwelling) Shall be imprisonment not less than 1 nor more than 10 years.	\$ 9-2207 Habitual criminals Act. After two previous felony convictions, a third felony conviction shall be punished by imprisonment for life.

\$ 10-701 1st Degree (Dwelling) Shall be imprisoned not less than 10 nor more than 20 years, and be disfranchised for period. 2nd Degree (Non-dwelling) Shall be imprisoned not less than 2 nor more than 5 years and disfranchised for period.	\$ 10-3001 Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not less than 1 year nor more than 10 years and fine not exceeding \$500 and disfranchisement for determinate period.	\$ 10-1704 Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not less than 2 nor more than 20 years and fined not less than \$1 nor more than \$1,000 and be disfranchised for determinate period.	\$ 10-1201 Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not less than 2 nor more than 21 years. (female - child under 12, punishment shall be life imprisonment.	\$ 10-1706 Penalty: shall be fined not exceeding \$500. In case of three such convictions within two years penalty shall be imprisonment for not more than one year.
