Penalty: (\$20 - \$100 value) shall be fine not more than \$300 or imprisonment with or without hard labor, for not more than 2 years, or both.	14 § 67 Same as larceny (Greater penalty for 2nd offense, etc.)	14 § 42 Penalty: for aggravated rape shall be death. 14 § 43 Penalty: for rape shall be imprisonment at hard labor for not less than 1 nor more than 20 years.	14 § 95 Penalty: for illegal carrying of weapons shall be fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 1 year or both. (Additional penalties for second and third convictions - provisions).
