§ 28.305 If convicted (nighttime) Penalty: shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 15 years. § 28.306 If convicted (daytime) Penalty: shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or fine of not more than \$2500.	§ 28.588 If convicted, Penalty: shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment not more than 5 years or by fine of not more than \$2500.	§ 28.371 If convicted, Penalty: shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment not more than 10 years or fine not exceeding \$5,000.	§ 28.788 If convicted, Penalty: shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for life or for any term of years.	§ 28.1423, 28.1424 If convicted, of carrying with unlawful intent or carrying concealed without license, penalty shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or fine not more than \$2500.
