§§ 104-1048 1st Degree: Death unless the jury recommends life imprisonment. 2nd Degree: Shall be imprisoned for not less than 20 years, the maximum is life.	§§ 1050-1053 1st Degree: Imprisonment for not more than 20 years. 2nd Degree: Imprisonment for not exceeding 15 years, or a fine not more than \$1,000 or both.	§§ 2120-2127 1st Degree: Imprisonment for not less than 10 years nor more than 30 years. 2nd Degree: Imprisonment not exceeding 15 years.	§§ 240-243 1st Degree: (intent to kill, . . . armed) Imprisonment for not exceeding 10 years. 2nd Degree: Imprisonment for not exceeding 5 years or a fine not more than \$1,000 or both.	§§ 220-227 1st Degree: (night-time) Penalty: Imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years. 2nd Degree: Imprisonment for a term not exceeding 25 years.	§§ 1941, 1942 2nd & 3rd conviction of felony - if crime is punishable for less than life - person must be imprisoned the minimum not less than half the longest term prescribed for a first conviction and the maximum not longer than twice such longest term. Provides that the minimum not be less than 5 years. 4th conviction of felony - not less than 15 years and maximum is life.

§§ 400-407 1st Degree (Nighttime) Penalty: The minimum of which shall not be less than 10 years nor more than 30 years. 2nd Degree (Daytime) For a term not exceeding 15 years.	§§ 1294 1st Degree (Nighttime) Imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years. 2nd Degree Penalty: Imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years.	§§ 305, 1935 (Bank employees) Penalty: Imprisonment not more than 7 years or by fine not more than \$1,000 or both.	§§ 2010 1st Degree For not more than 20 years. 2nd Degree Penalty: Imprisonment for not more than 10 years.	§ 1897, 1935 (Certain weapons) Penalty: A felony, Imprisonment not more than 7 years, or by fine not more than \$1,000 or both. (Other weapons) Penalty: A misdemeanor, but is a felony if person has been previously convicted of a crime. Misdemeanor - imprisonment for not more than 1 year or by fine not more than \$50 or both.
