(under \$500) Penalty: shall be imprisoned for not more than one year or fined not more than \$500 or both.	§ 11-4-3. See Larceny	§ 11-37-1. Penalty: shall be imprisoned for life or for any term not less than 10 years.	§ 11-47-42. Penalty: shall be fined not more than \$500, or by imprisonment not more than a year, or both.
