Penalty: shall suffer death unless jury recommends mercy, imprisoned not ex- ceeding 40 years nor less than five years.	§16-145. Penalty: shall be fined not more than \$100 and not less than \$20, or imprisoned not more than 30 nor less than 10 days.
