

AIRPORTS (SURFACE TRAFFIC).

No. 40 of 1960.

An Act to make Provision with respect to the Control
of Surface Traffic at Airports.

[Assented to 10th June, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Airports (Surface Traffic) Act* 1960. Short title.
2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation. Commencement.
- 3.—(1.) In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears— Interpretation.
“ airport ” means—
 - (a) an aerodrome owned or held under lease by the Commonwealth, or owned by the Crown in right of a Territory of the Commonwealth or by the Administration of a Territory of the Commonwealth, and operated in pursuance of the *Air Navigation Act* 1920–1960 or of the regulations under that Act; or
