AIR NAVIGATION 1

An Act to give effect to certain International ConNos. 15 of 1950,
28 of 1952. BY AIR, TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE GENERAL REGULA-TION AND CONTROL OF AIR NAVIGATION, AND FOR PUR-POSES CONNECTED THEREWITH OR INCIDENTAL THERETO.

1. This Act may be cited as the Air Navigation Act. Short title.

2. (1) Regulations may be made under this Act em-Power to grant powering the Minister by Order to grant exemption exemption from any of the previous of this Act to such classes or from from any of the provisions of this Act to such classes or operation of Act. description of aircraft or persons as may be prescribed in the regulations or to any aircraft or person belonging to any such prescribed class or description of aircraft or persons, to such extent or subject to such terms, conditions or restrictions as may be so prescribed.

(2) The Minister may, on the occurrence of any public emergency, by Order exempt any aircraft or person or class or description of aircraft or persons from any of the provisions of this Act to such extent or subject to such terms, conditions or restrictions as may appear to him to be necessary in the public interest, notwithstanding that he is not empowered to do so by regulations referred to in subsection (1).

(3) Every Order made by the Minister in pursuance of the regulations referred to in subsection (1) or the powers conferred by subsection (2) shall be as valid and

effectual as though it were herein enacted.
