air routes: 1) Moscow-Novosibirsk-Irkutsk-Ulan-Bator-Pekin; 2) Alma-Ata-Kul'dzha-Urumchi; 3) Chita-Shen'ian-Pekin (Article 1). The Main Administration of the Civil Air Fleet Attached to the USSR Council of Ministers ("AEROFLOT") and the Administration of the Civil Air Fleet Attached to the State Council of the Chinese People's Republic (UGVF) shall conclude a separate agreement regarding all questions of technical and commercial exploitation of above mentioned air routes (Article 2). Aircraft, their crew, passengers, luggage, cargo and mail shall be subject to the laws of the contracting party on whose territory they shall occur to be. (Art. 4). All earlier treaties re-air communications between parties are repealed (Art. 8). The agreement shall be in force 5 yrs from the date of signing and shall be considered extended for further 5 years unless denounced 6 months prior to the expiration of the current period of time. (Art. 9, par. 1)
