2. the corresponding decentralized organization of accounting and auditing services, using to this end the existing field offices if the State Accounting Office and of the Court of Accounts. Articles 10 through 13. [Omitted; they contain detailed provisions concerning the staff and personnel regulations of the new organization.]

TEMPORARY AND FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 14. Expenditures required for the operation of the Inspectorate General of Civil Aviation shall be paid from appropriations contained in the estimated budget of the Ministry of Defense, concerning the services of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation and Air Traffic, and personnel expenditures to the extent relating to the personnel of the Ministry of Defense for Air assigned to the Ministry of Transport and Civil Aviation pursuant to Article 12 above, until such appropriations and expenditures will be entered in the estimated expenditure budget of the Ministry of Transport and Civil Aviation.

The new general expenditures, estimated at Lit. 37,300,000, shall be charged to the Reserve Fund for Unforeseen Expenditures in the Estimated Expenditure Budget of the Ministry of the Treasury.

The Minister of the Treasury is authorized to issue decrees introd-

ducing the necessary budget variations.

Article 15. [Omitted: it contains provisions concerning the trans-

fer of properties and assets pertaining to civil aviation.]

Article 16. The Directorate General of Civil Aviation and Air Traf-

fic in the Ministry of Defense is hereby abolished.

Article 17. This Law shall enter into effect 90 days after its publication in the Official Gazette.
