of an airdrome or air navigation aid shall obtain authorization from the Minister of Transportation. However, the same shall not apply where the operator of an airdrome or air navigation aid is deceased and the heir succeeds to the status of the deceased.

2. Under the proviso of the preceding paragraph, a report to that

effect shall be made to the Minister of Transportation.

Article 46. Installation or Administration of an Airdrome, etc. by the Minister of Transportation.—The provisions of Articles 34, 40 and 41, paragraph 1 shall apply where the Minister of Transportation installs any airdrome or air navigation aid or makes alterations of the facilities thereof.

2. The provisions of Article 38, paragraph 1, Article 41, paragraph 5 (with respect to aeronautical obstruction light mentioned in the same article, paragraph 1) and Article 44 shall apply where the Minister of Transportation administrates an airdrome or air navigation

Article 47. Delegation to Airdrome Order.—Except for the provisions of this Chapter, any matters necessary for the designation of an airway, installation of an airdrome or air navigation aid, or the examination of an application for modification and airdrome installation work shall be determined by a State Council Decree.

CHAPTER V-OPERATION OF AIRCRAFT

Article 48. Display of Nationality Mark, etc.—No aircraft shall be used for air navigation unless the nationality mark, registration mark and the owner's name or title are displayed on the aircraft in accordance with the provisions of an Ordinance of the Ministry of Transportation. However, the same shall not apply where permitted by the proviso of Article 13, paragraph 3.

Article 49. Compulsory Radio Equipment.—No aircraft shall be

used for air navigation in the following cases unless equipped with radio apparatus as specified by an Ordinance of the Ministry of

(1) When it is used for air transportation;

(2) When it is making a flight under instrument flight rule conditions in a traffic control area or zone;

(3) When it is making a flight over areas designated and made

publicly known by the Minister of Transportation.

Article 50. Aircraft Logbook and Safety Equipment.—All aircraft shall carry a flight logbook of such form as may be specified by an Ordinance of the Ministry of Transportation and when the aircraft has been used for air navigation, or repaired or remodelled, such items as may be specified by an Ordinance of the Ministry of Transportation shall be entered without delay into the aircraft logbook. However, the same shall not apply where permitted by the proviso of Λ rticle 13. paragraph 3.

2. No aircraft shall be used for air navigation unless equipped with parachutes, life jackets, emergency signal lights and other emergency equipment as specified by an Ordinance of the Ministry of Transpor-

3. No aircraft (excluding aircraft specified by an Ordinance of the Ministry of Transportation) shall be used for air navigation unless it
