AIR NAVIGATION (SAFETY OF NAVIGATION)

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

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An Ordinance to ensure the safety of aircraft in flight by
by imposing restrictions upon the use and enjoyment
of land and upon the erection of buildings in the
vicinity of aerodromes.

[23rd October, 1941]

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Air Navigation
(Safety of Navigation) Ordinance.

2. Definitions:—

“aerodrome” means any area of ground or water
licensed under the provisions of the Colonial Air
Navigation Order, 1955, or under the control of
Government or of Her Majesty’s Air Force for the
landing and departure of aircraft;

“aircraft” means any type of air-supported vehicle,
