

VIETNAM

The Republic of Vietnam has no basic air law. The Secretary of State for Public Works and Communications has issued Regulations for Civil Aviation¹ to which Vietnam is a member. This regulation has been issued in form of a decision² by the Director of Civil Aviation acting for and on behalf of the Secretary of State, and includes four annexes:

Annex 1: General provisions—Definitions and measurements;

Annex 2: Rules of the air;

Annex 3: Functions of organizations regulating civil aviation;

Annex 4: Procedures for flight service.

The regulation is based on Annexes 2 (including Amendment 5) and 11 (including Amendment 9) of the Chicago Convention and on Document ICAO 444/RAC/501/6 (including Amendment 4), and its organisation generally follows that of the ICAO documents.
