IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Envelopes containing nine data processing cards are being distributed to State agencies for redistribution to local offices, in sufficient number to provide at least one envelope for each applicant. These envelopes contain prepunched and coded cards, as follows:

1. Four red-printed reference Answer Cards, containing space for the applicant to enter the names and addresses of his references, and identifying information about himself and his relationship to the reference.
