and program design would be eliminated. Finally, I would like to suggest that Congress consider more specific language in section 6(e) so that the determination of level of expenditures for such activities be averaged over the 5-year period immediately prior to initiation of a demonstration cities program. Gentlemen, thank you for this opportunity to make this brief presentation.
