

new knowledge and technology to replace outmoded and inadequate practices and systems. The final steps for abating solid waste pollution will have to be taken by the people in their villages and cities, their counties and States. Undue delay, for any reason, in taking advantage of proven opportunities for effective and salutary waste management will simply make a mockery of our professed aspirations for clean air, water, and land and a reasonable share of the natural beauty upon which the human spirit thrives.
