The last column shows expenditures for the most recent year prior to receipt of Federal program grants. Such grants were first authorized by the Clean Air Act, adopted December 1963, and were first made from fiscal year 1965 appropriations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.—This table shows the budgets of local and regional air pollution control agencies as of July 1966. The Federal program grants shown in the 5th column are awards made from the fiscal year 1966 appropriation.
