- PART I Textbooks currently being published in dual editions. The two versions are identical except that the "multi-ethnic" version contains bi-racial illustrations and includes in some cases some intercultural textual matter. Identifying symbols are indicated. p. 3
- PART II Specific texts selected by the Virginia State Board of Education in previous years and presumably to be considered for reselection in the fall of 1966. The titles listed are those books which have been recently revised in order to purposefully include intercultural material. p. 5
- PART III. Newly available books which have presumably not been considered for selection by the Virginia State Board before, and which are judged to have emphasized to some degree an intercultural approach. All the available texts in these subject areas were studied; these titles were selected as being outstanding in objectivity, currency and because of their presentation of multi-ethnic material. p. 9
- PART IV. Some of the available and inexpensive textbook-type material with which local schools may supplement basic texts with bi-racial, intercultural information. p. 14
