agree with all of the provisions of this proposal—and that is often the case—its decisive acceptance speaks abundantly for the ability and persuasive talents of Senator Long.

Commendation also goes to those many Senators who supported the proposal with strong and clear arguments and also to those who offered their own convincing views. We therefore thank the distinguished senior Senator from Delaware [Mr. Williams], the ranking minority member of the committee, the senior Senator from Indiana [Mr. Hartke], the senior Senator from New

Hampshire [Mr. Cotton], and the senior Senator from Missouri [Mr. Symington]. Similarly commended are the senior Senator from Kansas [Mr. Carlson], the senior Senator from Texas [Mr. Yarborough], the senior Senator from Vermont [Mr. Aiken], and the senior Senator from Tennessee [Mr. Gore].

Finally, I wish to extend my appreciation again to this entire body for joining to dispose of another proposal in the orderly and efficient manner which will help so much in enabling us to reach an adjournment sine die.
