- "(B) Drugs and biologicals shall be determined to
  be qualified drugs only if they can legally be obtained by
  the user pursuant to a prescription of a physician; except
  that the Formulary Committee may include certain drugs
- 5 and biologicals not requiring such a prescription if it de-
- 6 termines such drugs or biologicals to be of a lifesaving nature.
- 7 "(C) In the interest of orderly, economical, and equi-
- 8 table administration of the benefits provided under section
- 9 1832(a)(3), the Formulary Committee may, by regula-
- 10 tion, provide that a drug or biological otherwise regarded
- 11 as being a qualified drug shall not be so regarded when
- 12 prescribed below certain minimum quantities.
- "(3) In determining the allowable expense for any **1**3 quantity of any qualified drug, the Formulary Committee 14 shall give due consideration to recognized pricing guides for 15 drugs, and of other pertinent factors, with a view to deter-16 mining with respect to each qualified drug a schedule of 17 prices for various quantities thereof which reflects the cost 18 thereof to the ultimate dispensor of the drug plus a reason-19 able fee for the preparation, handling, and distribution 20 thereof to the consumer thereof. In any case in which a 21 drug or biological is available by generic name and one or 22more trade names any one of which is different from such 23 generic name the cost of such drug or biological, for pur-24
