9. Economic effects
(a) Effects on personal incomes of persons served or involved and on the distribution of personal income. Foreign Service annuitants supplement their annuities by teaching, writing, and other activities for which they are qualified. Some have outside income from investments, and a few have small social security and Veterans' Administration pensions. It is estimated that on the average, Foreign Service annuitants derive 40 percent of their total income from the above sources.
