## P.L. 64-347 - Smith-Hughes and George Barden Acts

PURPOSE: To provide vocational education and teacher training in agriculture, trade, industry, and home economics.

<u>DISTRICT PROGRAM</u>: The district for many years has provided a variety of courses with funds from these acts. They have provided the incentive for pilot programs extending vocational education into areas of training needed by the citizens of the community. Merchandising, distributive education, and cosmetology courses are recent examples.

RESULTS: As new demands for vocational training have become known, the district has offered new programs. Many citizens of the community who enrolled in and completed programs supported by funds from these acts are now gainfully employed.

CONCLUSION: These acts have shown that Federal funds can be adjusted to changing community needs for new skills.
