

P.L. 81-874 - Impact Aid for School Operation

PURPOSE: To provide funds for basic education programs for children whose parents live and/or work on Federal property.



25% OF SAN DIEGO CHILDREN ARE FEDERALLY CONNECTED

DISTRICT PROGRAM: Children of Federally-connected families have been admitted to the nearest school and provided the same educational program as for all other district pupils, without separate identification and without segregation.

RESULTS: Education provided Federally-connected children on an equal basis to education provided local children by local tax funds has meant that all children can receive a better basic education program.

CONCLUSION: General aid for basic education programs is essential regardless of the source of funds. It is the basic education program that assures all children an equal chance to learn.
