urgency in view of its school problems reported daily in the press. Despite wide-spread community insistence upon the development of a comprehensive plan for the children in close to 900 public schools and 200 non-public schools participating in Title I projects, the pleas fall on deaf ears. If the present drift continues without legislative clarification, it will be difficult to determine the effect of appropriations of billions of dollars beyond aid to perpetuate old patterns of failure.
