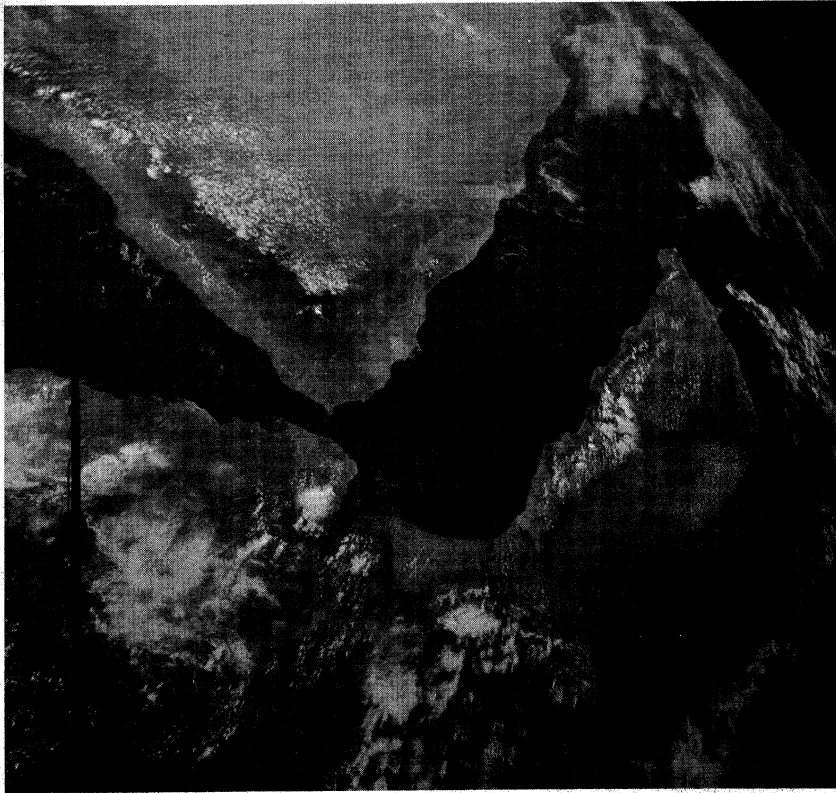

MR. HJORNEVIK'S PRESENTATION TO THE TEAGUE COMMITTEE
