questions we might need to ask you or management, we can have the opportunity of bringing you back for those questions.

Mr. Leighty. I will make myself available.

Mr. Springer. Mr. Chairman. The Chairman. Mr. Springer.

Mr. Springer. I think there are many members who are not here today who would like to have your statement in their offices. Could you supply these over the weekend?

Mr. Leighty. I believe a copy was laid at each Congressman's

position.

Mr. Springer. I meant to their office.

Mr. LEIGHTY. Yes, we will arrange to do that.

The CHAIRMAN. Again, thank you.

This will conclude our hearings for today, until next Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock.
