Purpose: To determine the characteristics of the Job Corps population at different time periods and to relate those characteristics to Census data and to selective service data.

Method : The contractor classified the data from the OEO Form 16 tape into four groups: enrollees, rejectees, no shows, and disciplinary discharges. For each classification, the contractor tabulated by sex, program and time period a given number of study variables. With the above information, the contractor prepared six reports on the following topics:

- a) Changes in Job Corps population with time.
- b) Comparison of Job Corps population with Census data and with draftee and draft rejectee populations.
- c) Changes in Job Corps rejectees with time.
- d) Comparisons of Job Corps rejectee population with Census and with draftee and draft rejectee populations.
- e) Comparisons of Job Corps characteristics of Disciplinary Dismissals with the Job Corps Enrollee and Rejectee populations.
- f) Changes in Job Corps no-show population over time.

Form of Report: The contractor submitted the six (6) reports in draft form, before February 24, 1967, to Project Manager for approval. After approval, six (6) final reports, ten (10) copies each, were delivered.
