TITLE: Follow-up Survey of Job Corps Graduates

GROUP CONDUCTING STUDY: Opinion Research Corporation, Research Park
Princeton, New Jersey

TIME SPAN: June 1, 1966 - August 1, 1966

CURRENT STATUS: Completed

Purpose: To evaluate the Job Corps Training Programs by questioning Job Corps placements (former Corpsmen with verified placements) concerning:

- living and social conditions
- reactions to personnel at Job Corps Centers
- reactions to experiences at Job Corps Centers
- why and how entered Job Corps
- type of program followed in Job Corps
- plans for the future
- activities after graduation from Job Corps

Method : To assess the above factors, the contractor:

- developed, pre-tested, and administered an in-depth questionnaire to 500 Job Corps placements, now employed or continuing education
- questionnaires were mailed out; contractor attempted by phone or in person to contact subjects who did not return the mailed forms
- contractor supplied the Evaluation & Research Branch with:
 - detailed cross-tabulations of answers
 - raw data for open-ended questions
