Chairman Perkins. Just give me a "yes" or "no." Mr. Addonizio. Yes, I believe the area boards should be abolished, because they have created more problems than they have solved. I

would also like to just mention this, that I was under the impression that this hearing was to discuss the antipoverty program, because certainly. I would be very happy to enumerate those considerations that I would like to have, not only for the city of Newark, but also every other city that we need—I would like to have the Congress immediately pass funds for the demonstration grants to the municipalities, because this is constituted in a constitute that is constituted as a second program of the city of the demonstration grants to the municipalities, because this is something that is sorely needed in another area that is before them now.
