J. Richard Crout, MD, director of the Bureau of Drugs of the FDA, recently testified before the Senate subcommittee on monopoly chaired by Senator Gaylord Nelson on the issue of pharmaceutical industry "dominance" over continuing medical education.

Enclosed is a preprint of an editorial challenging Dr. Crout's testimony, which will appear in the August 1, 1976 issue of Patient Care, a controlled circulation publication received by approximately 100,000 primary physicians twenty-one times a year.

Because of your membership on a congressional committee involved with matters of health, we felt you would want this editorial called to your attention. Although we properly can speak only for Patient Care, we believe — and we hope you do, too — that the issues raised by Dr. Crout in his testimony deserve a balanced review.
