

morphine (Fig. 12). The responses to the 1.2 mg dose of buprenorphine as measured by the MBG Scale scores and the opiate symptoms scores were less than that produced by 0.6 mg of buprenorphine. Again, buprenorphine did not produce significantly greater PCAG or LSD Scale scores than morphine. These results suggest that 1.0 mg of buprenorphine may produce maximum effects with these effects in the range of 30 mg of morphine.

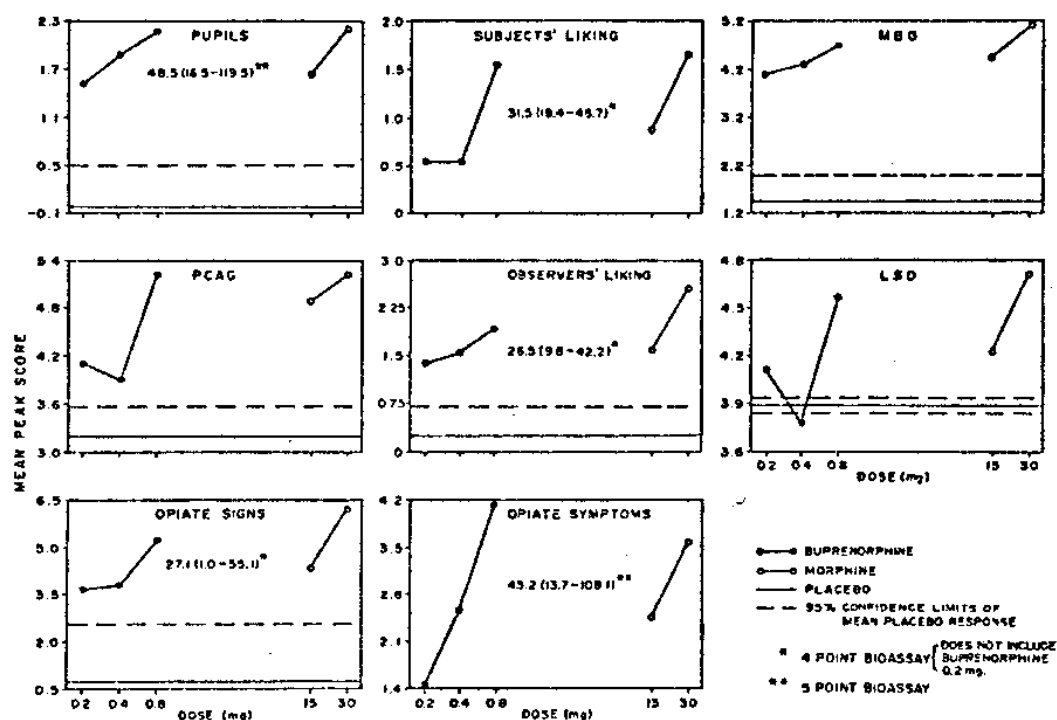


Figure 11. Dose response curves for the comparison of buprenorphine, morphine and placebo utilizing mean peak responses. Numbers represent relative potencies and 95% confidence limits expressed as mg of morphine equivalent to 1 mg of buprenorphine.
