From the 12th hour on, however, the PCAG scores became significantly elevated while the previously elevated MBG scores returned to control levels.

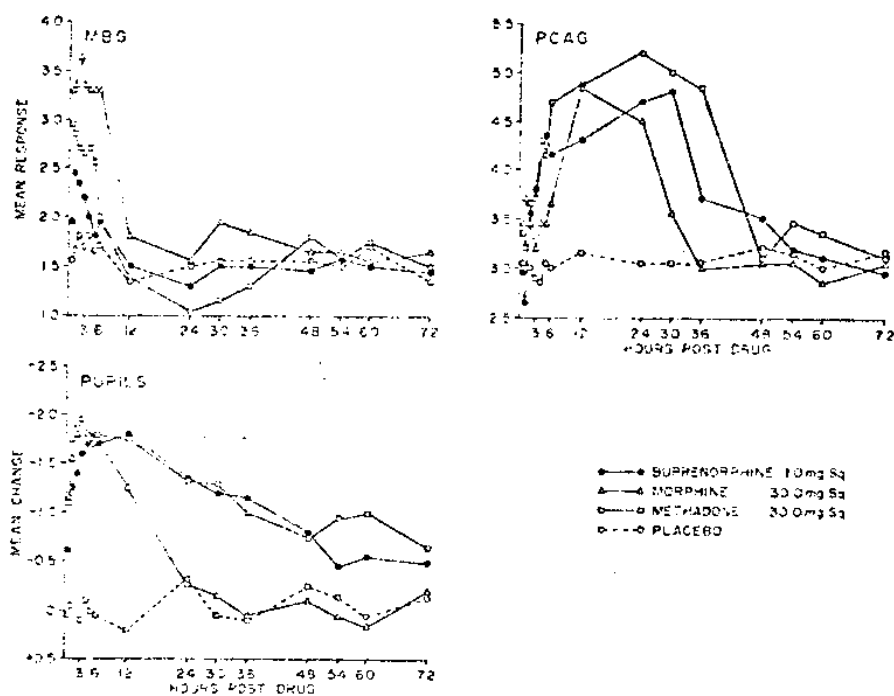


Figure 13. Comparison of the duration of action of buprenorphine, morphine, methadone and placebo in constricting pupils, producing PCAG and MBG Scale scores.
