Although a serious amphetamine problem still exists in this Region, the growing abuse of other Schedule II drugs, such as Preludin and Desoxyn and Schedules III and IV anorectics, such as Fenfluramine, Phentermine and Phendimetrazine has rapidly outplaced the older established amphetamines.
