At the request of ENFA the BNDD Laboratory Division queried various State Forensic Laboratories. The results of that query are attached.

Information obtained from Strasenburgh, Rochester, New York, shows 900 kilograms of Amphetamine resin complex have been expected from the plant at Rochester, New York, to the plant in Mexico City since March 1970. This amount of resin is growth to produce 45,000,000 d.u. of Bifetamina. Strasenburgh is only one of a number of firms in Mexico which is producing Amphetamine produces. The amount of Amphetamine resin being shipped to benico City coupled with the extent of diversion of products leing produced by the firm in Mexico City exposes a Situation of obvious over production. This over production and subsequent diversion is creating a situation which is detrimental to the health and safety of the public.

Action should therefore be taken to deny renewal of export registration to R.J. Strasenburgh, Rochester, New York. As the renewal officer this firm is February 1972 action to deny renewal should be taken before that date.
