

LIMITED CIRCULATION

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It is recommended that the ABN's and/or deputies of the concerned regions be brought into headquarters and a meeting held to determine the need for additional manpower and funds to assist their operations in alleviating the problem. It is recommended that they be in headquarters on October 19 and 20. After the meeting and a determination of required manpower and availability of funds, it is recommended that a task force be in the field in operation no later than November 5, 1971.

This task force will serve the dual purpose of developing additional intelligence information with primary emphasis on the Biphosamine situation and also identifying and immobilizing major Biphosamine distributors in the United States. The task force should remain in operation until approximately January 15, 1972 at which time any cases initiated would be concluded. These cases, combined with the intelligence gathered, will be utilized as the basis for issuing a Show Cause Order to Strassburgh Laboratories-Rochester, N. Y. denying their re-registration as "an exporter". The Show Cause Order must be issued prior to February 1972.

Intelligence information obtained concerning the "mini-Beanie" and LAF situations will be utilized for future programs designed to eliminate these abuse situations.

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
