

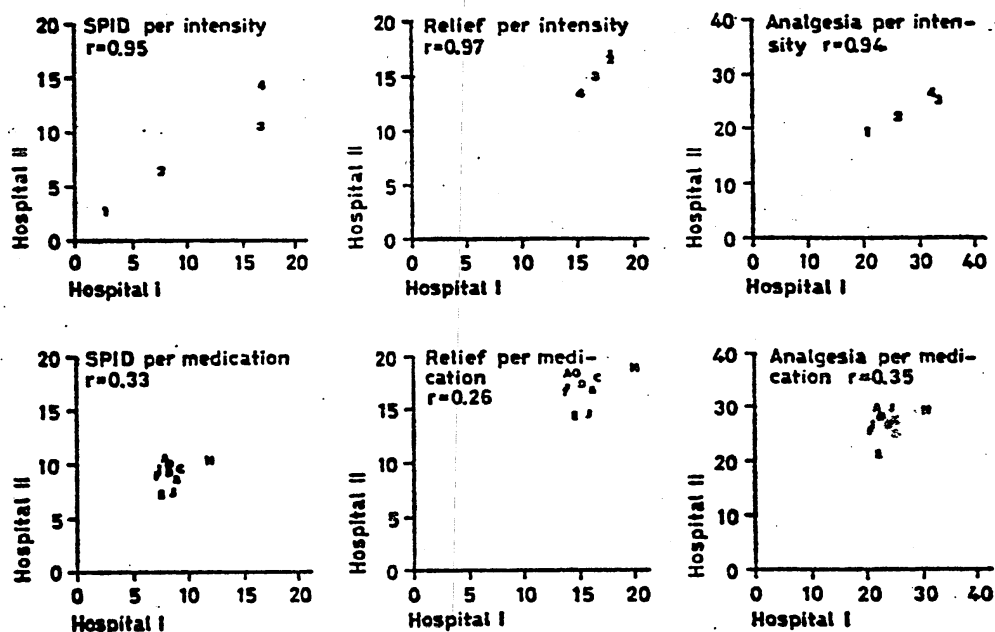


Fig. 1. Variance analyses of SPID, relief and analgesia score data (table II) indicate the presence of significant primary interactions between the institutions and pain intensity effects and between the institutions and medication effects. These relationships which exist between the interacting main effects are presented for each of the measures of effectiveness. The medications are identified in table III. The relative positions of the pain intensity strata and of the treatment groups indicate the degree of agreement between the 2 institutions.

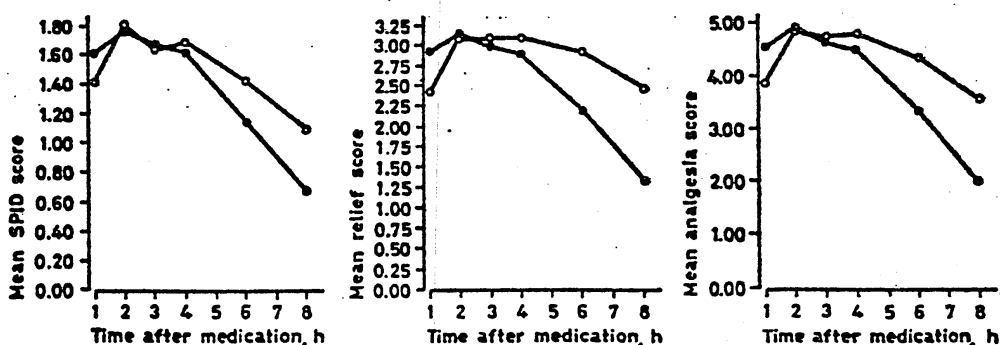


Fig. 2. The response time curves of the overall SPID, relief, and analgesia score data are presented for each institution. ● = Hospital I; □ hospital II.
