cally, I might add that at this point we are not considering drugs sold over the counter—so-called OTC—for the same indications as prescription psychotropic agents. We will return to these OTC preparations later.

Chart 2 ¹ shows the percentage of all psychotropic prescriptions filled in U.S. drugstores attributable to each of the major drug classes in the year 1967.
