e. *Phlebitis and Thrombophlebitis of Other Sites, ICD 464* (Table 3)—As in the previous category, deaths of women

age 15-44 have increased consistently in both white and nonwhite. In 1960 there were 45 deaths of women age 15-44, whereas in 1966 there were 82. No trend was apparent among 15-44-year-old men

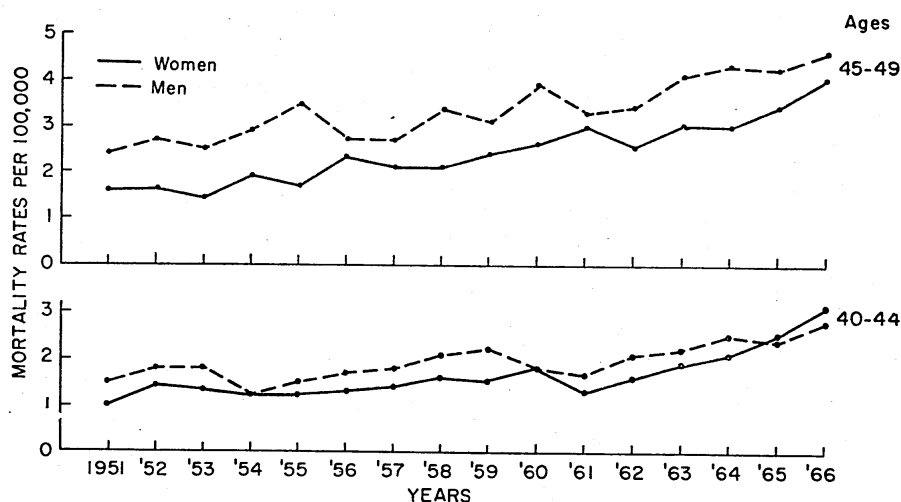


Figure 4—US mortality 1951-1966 from diseases of veins, etc. ICD (7th Rev.) 460-8, by sex and five-year age group; white, ages 40-49.

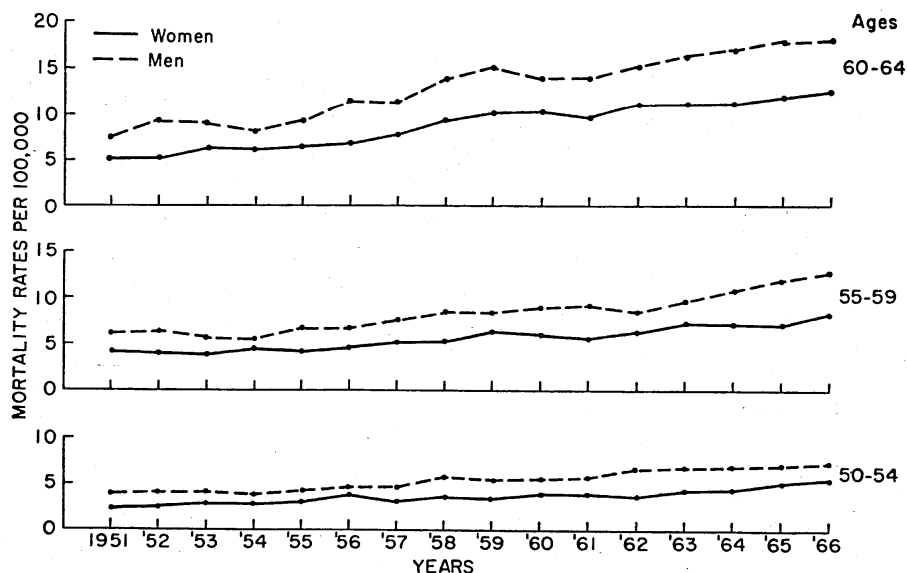


Figure 5—US mortality 1951-1966 from diseases of veins, etc. ICD (7th Rev.) 460-8, by sex and five-year age group; white, ages 50-64.
