

4. An announcement letter from Hines, Illinois, VA Marketing Center dated March 16, 1972, was read to the group. Of special interest was the portion relating to Robitussin's deletion from depot stock. The Committee agreed to the use of the generic equivalent of glyceryl Guaiacolate syrup available from depot.
5. The secretary distributed copies of Station memorandum No. 522-11-71 to all services concerned. This memorandum is the "official" station drug policy. Members were asked to review certain portions of the memorandum and suggest possible revisions. No suggestions were forthcoming; so, the memorandum will be considered current.
6. For the purposes of information and review, the secretary read selected excerpts from VA Manual M2, Part VII. These portions reflect official VA policy regarding the giving of medications on discharge of patients, proper routing of aid and attendance prescriptions, as well as "housebound."
7. There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:10 p.m.
